Club Opens for Jackpot Shooting On Saturday, January 7th, 2012

The Janesville Conservation Club hours of operation are 10 a.m. to dusk and will start the New Year with the beginning of the Saturday Jackpot Shooting season. The club is offering the regular Jackpot Shoot of 50 clay targets, 25 clay targets from the 16 yard line and 25 clay targets determined by the number of targets hit at the 16 yard line with a 23 yard minimum.

The Summer League warm-up starts on March 21st and concludes on April 4th, with leagues starting on Wednesday, April 10th. We will again offer an 8 week individual league starting on May 9th if enough people are interested. The Summer Doubles and Wobble leagues start on Wednesday, May 9th and go for 11 weeks.

Club Shoot and Summer League Awards

Summer League Awards and club shoot will be Sunday, August 26th. This is a fun shoot day with food and refreshments furnished by the club. There will be random white targets and prizes given for those who break them.

2011 Charity Shoot Success

A very successful 2011 Charity Shoot raised \$3,300.00 in donations. - Daily Purse Lewis Class
- Lewis Class runs decided by dice roll
- You may enter more than once; Each score has a chance to win.
- 50 Straights pay 50% of Jackpot #1, if eligible
- Eligibility rules are you must have entered the event at least 3 (three) times prior to the 50 straight. This means the 4th (fourth) time you become eligible.
- Prior to the final Jackpot on May 5th entrants must have entered the event

<u>5 times</u> to be eligible for the Final Jackpot Purse.

• Final Jackpot Purse will be paid out opposite of the Daily Purse. Each time you enter the event you earn a point towards the Final Purse. The more times you shoot the more points you have on the final day.

All money will be paid out on the final day!

Janesville Conservation Club Promotes Gun Safety Programs

Throughout the year the Janesville Conservation Club hosts Hunter Safety programs for classes up to 40 students. Highly accredited and trained instructors teach the basic fundamentals of gun and hunting safety.

Watch the Janesville Conservation website, the local newspaper and the DNR web-site for information on up-coming classes. This program has been very successful and space is limited.

Listed below are some of the benefits of good firearm safety training.

• Firearm-related fatalities in the U.S. have been decreasing consistently since record keeping began in 1903 and dramatically in the last10 years

• Accidental firearm-related fatalities are substantially lower compared to the number of Accidental deaths caused by other injury types

• Hunting is one of the safest forms of recreation in the United States.

The Janesville Conservation Club is a member of the National Rifle Association (NRA) and the National Sports Shooting Foundation (NSSF) and supports many of their programs to keep shooting ranges open and allow for the right to bear arms.

Note: Many of the Fall Hunter Safety Classes we have had to turn away as many as 100 who have come to register. Spring classes are traditionally smaller and easier to get into. These classes are generally scheduled for February and March so watch the club web site or the DNR web site for scheduled classes at the Janesville Conservation Club in the <u>Spring</u> of 2012.
