Club Opens for Jackpot Shooting On Saturday, January 4th, 2014

The Janesville Conservation Club hours of operation are 10 a.m. to dusk and will start the New Year with the beginning of the Saturday Jackpot Shooting season. The club is offering the regular Jackpot Shoot of 50 clay targets, 25 clay targets from the 16 yard line and 25 clay targets determined by the number of targets hit at the 16 yard line with a 23 yard minimum.

The Summer League warm-up starts on March 12th and concludes on April 2nd, with leagues starting on Wednesday, April 9th. We will offer an 8 week individual Doubles and/or Wobble league starting on May 7th. And completing with Summer League July 30th.

Club Shoot and Summer League Awards

Summer League Awards and club shoot will be Sunday, September 7th. **This is a fun shoot day with food and refreshments furnished by the club. There will be random white targets and prizes given for those who break them.**

25 Targets from 16 yard score (23 yd Min)

- Daily Purse – Lewis Class
- Lewis Class runs decided by dice roll
- You may enter more than once; Each score has a chance to win.
- 50 Straights pay 50% of Jackpot #1, if eligible
- Eligibility rules are you must have entered the event at least 3 (three) times prior to the 50 straight. This means the 4th (fourth) time you become eligible.
- Prior to the final Jackpot on May 3rd entrants must have entered the

event **5 times** to be eligible for the Final Jackpot Purse.

- Final Jackpot Purse will be paid out opposite of the Daily Purse. Each time you enter the event you earn a point towards the Final Purse. The more times you shoot the more points you have on the final day.

All money will be paid out on the final day!

2014 YOUTH SHOOTING SPORTS



The Youth Shooting Program focuses on teaching American-style trap and firearms safety in an environment designed for personal growth and development. Shooters in the program work on the fundamentals of trap through a series of drills, discussions, and demonstrations. Once youth shooters are comfortable with their progress, they start participating in competitive ATA shoots as members of the ATA's youth and collegiate program—called AIM.

ATA stands for the Amateur Trapshooting Association. AIM stands for Academics, Integrity, and Marksmanship.

Space on the team is limited.

Requirements for the Shooting Team

- Open to boys and girls 12 – 18 years old
- 12 gauge trap shotgun
- Help with team fundraising
- Help with club shoots
- Pay a \$125 entry fee
- Be a member of ATA and AIM (\$25)
